Based on information obtained from our raw material suppliers and outside service providers, this letter certifies that all parts and/or assemblies manufactured by Alexandria Industries comply with the most current requirements of the EU REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006.

To the best of our knowledge, all items manufactured and/or purchased by Alexandria Industries do not contain any substances listed on the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) above the allowable threshold of 0.1% w/w, as defined by the REACH Directive. As of Feb 2026, the ECHA Candidate List contains 253 SVHCs.
